



Hump Day Bowlers League – Season Conclusion Information

First, we hope all our Hump Day Bowlers and their families are well and taking care of themselves. It's been a very tough time for everyone. Most importantly, please make sure you are being vigilant in your health and well-being. You are a vital member to this group of bowlers and we look forward to returning in the Fall.

Unfortunately, it looks as though this difficulty will last longer than expected. With that being said, based on votes received from every team, the vast majority decided to finish the season early. Being supportive to all members, ending the season and returning league funds to you, will be of great help and benefit to everyone.

Here's information about how final team and individual results were calculated. These were based on league rules, USBC regulations and from consensus between league officers.

Individual Awards – Scratch Game, Scratch Series, Handicap Game, and Handicap Series winners were determined as of 3/11/2020, our last night of bowling. That also includes awards for Most Improved and High Averages. All award winners must have bowled at least 27 (one-third of the season) games to be eligible. Payouts will be sent directly to individual winners.

Team Awards – Scratch Game, Scratch Series, Handicap Game, and Handicap Series winners were determined as of 3/11/2020, our last night of bowling. Winner for Trimester 3 was granted to the point leader as of 3/11/2020. The final team standings were determined as they would have, if Roll-Offs would have taken place. The Trimester Winners (no Wild Card Team this year), would have vied for the top places. All the other team standings were determined by Total Points Won Year-To-Date. Payouts will be sent to the team's captain, unless other direction is sent to the Treasurer.

NOTE: Prepayments/Monies Owed – As stated by League By-Laws, last 2 weeks shall be paid in advance. Those monies and any other prepayments, credits, or possible monies owed from late payments have been calculated per team. That information, in detail, will be sent along with payout amounts. **TEAM PAYMENTS WILL BE ADJUSTED BY ANY PREPAYMENTS/MONIES OWED FOR THE WHOLE TEAM.** We hope the team captain will be responsible to disburse the monies for team members in a fair and equitable manner. If the team would like monies disbursed and sent directly to team members, please contact the Treasurer.

Cash Payout methods – we would like to send cash payouts to bowlers via Venmo, or by check. If you do not have a Venmo account, checks will be sent. We have Venmo information for anyone that has submitted a Venmo payment to the league this year. If you would like to receive payment via Venmo, please be sure to "LIKE" the @HumpDay-BowlersLeague to connect with us.

Non-cash awards – there are other awards earned by individual and teams such as USBC badges and pins, IGBO national award pins, etc. These will be mailed to teams/individuals.

Notices: We plan to send out individual/team emails detailing cash payments and prizes awarded. We may ask for information such as mailing address, Venmo account name, or any changes that need to be made. To ensure your cash award payments are expedited, please respond as soon as possible. We will also want to verify your mailing address for any non-cash awards.

League Office Elections – We will finish our election process this year via email. We will be sending out Officer Nomination Acceptance forms to those nominated. For those nominated for a league officer, you'll receive a separate email regarding that. It has information to accept or decline your nomination. Once those have been received and tallied – all league members will receive an email to cast your ballot for next season's league officers. We hope you will all take a moment and reply with your vote.
